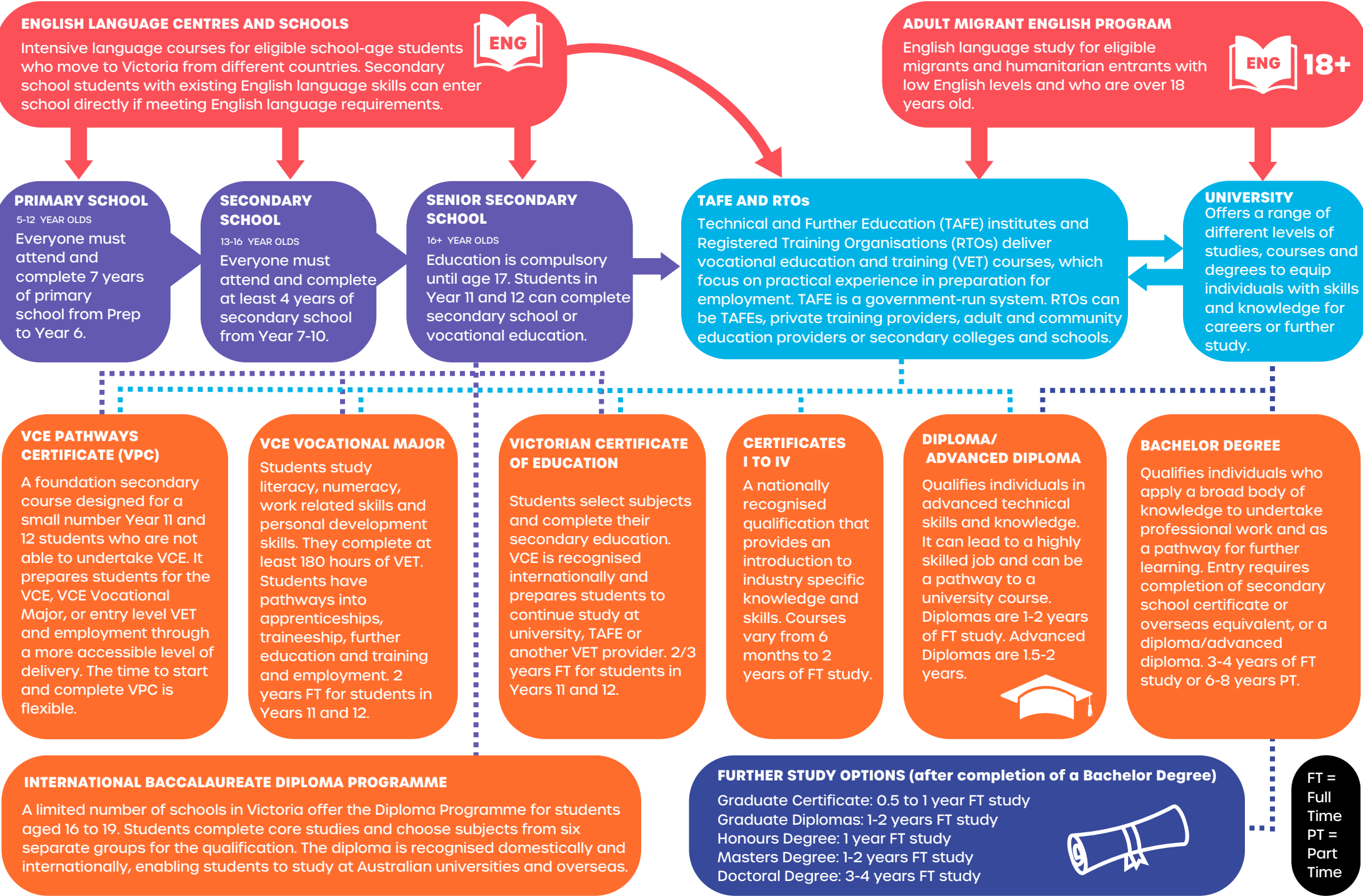


A MAP OF THE VICTORIAN EDUCATION SYSTEM

FINANCIAL SUPPORT

Centrelink - financial payments can be received while studying, training or completing an Australian Apprenticeship. Youth Allowance Austudy and ABSTUDY are available through Centrelink. Visit <https://www.servicesaustralia.gov.au>

Scholarships - sometimes offered by places of study to help with the cost of study, travel, books and housing.

MY EDUCATION

CMY's MY Education program provides resources and support crucial to the success of primary and secondary students' learning. MY Education delivers two key programs that support schools and community organisations to work with multicultural students.

Learning Beyond the Bell (LBB)

Across Victoria, (LBB) supports over 365 Out-of-School-Hours Learning Support Programs or OSHLSPs. These programs provide tuition and learning support to thousands of children and young people, including many from migrant and refugee backgrounds. To assist organisations with delivery of high quality and sustainable programs, LBB provides a range of support, training and resources for OSHLSP coordinators and volunteers.

Refugee Education Support Program (RESP)

RESP improves the educational outcomes of students from migrant and refugee backgrounds. It is a two-year program aimed at assisting schools to identify and implement strategies which have a positive impact on the achievement, engagement, and wellbeing outcomes of students from refugee backgrounds and their families.

RESP is a partnership between CMY, Foundation House and the Department of Education, delivered in collaboration with Catholic Education Commission of Victoria and the Association of Independent Schools Victoria.
